We ask all parents to consider the importance of education and to refrain from taking holidays during term time. This can cause significant absence and as the curriculum moves at such a fast pace will inevitably cause a detriment to children's progress in their learning. Year 6 SATs are administered in the week beginning Monday 13th May and Year 2 SATs through May - holidays must not be taken in these periods at all.
