NURSERY

We are delighted that our school Nursery will open in January 2020 - it will offer high quality early years' provision for 2, 3 and 4 year olds.

We will provide a safe and secure setting in which children have access to a vibrant and stimulating indoor and outdoor area. We will encourage children to develop their skills and independence through play based learning.

Our Nursery will provide term-time care and education and we will be open Monday to Friday from 9am to 3pm.
